POSITION DESCRIPTION

Reporting directly to the education director, the **Lead Low Strings Teaching Artist** is a skilled musician and educator responsible for teaching and leading cello and bass lessons, sectionals, and group classes. Classes will range from middle through high school at multiple school sites. Some of these classes may be co-taught. The ideal candidate will also be a dynamic team player with a strong work ethic. Lead teaching artists will work to support organizational goals and to ensure the highest quality experience program-wide, helping make Austin Soundwaves into a successful national model for collaborative music education.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead individual and group lessons on cello and bass
- Collaborate with the education director on curriculum, events, and pedagogical practices
- Collaborate with leadership team on planning and evaluation
- Ensure consistent, engaging, and effective pedagogy across partner schools
- Assist at program events, including concerts and workshops
- Provide onsite support for partner school concerts whenever possible
- Attend recruitment events at partner schools throughout the year
- Assist with select advocacy and fundraising events
- Represent Austin Soundwaves within the community, within Texas, and around the United States
